NOT JUST A COMMON OR GARDEN PHONE

The lightweight handset has a last number redial button that saves you dialling constantly engaged numbers.

There's hi-lo volume control that's handy if you're speaking in a noisy environment.

And a secrecy button allows you to make private remarks without being heard by the person on the end of the line.

On the Freeway's base unit (the part that

stays indoors and charges the handset when it's not being used) there's a page button that allows the user to be contacted from home, and an in-use indicator that shows when the handset is being used to make a call

THE INSIDE STORY

On those days when the weather prevents you working or relaxing outside, you'll find the Freeway just as valuable around the home. It certainly looks at home, a unique two-tone grey colour scheme will complement any decor

Freeway's base unit can be wall-mounted, quickly and simply, using the screws provided.

Freeway is fitted with the new style Inphone plugs which fit into Inphone sockets. British Telecom will be pleased to install these, virtually anywhere you want, quickly and at a reasonable cost.

Like all Inphones, Freeway is engineered to the highest standards and is fully tested and approved for connection to the British Telecom network. As all cordless phones use radio signals between the handset and base unit, call privacy cannot be guaranteed.

Under ideal radio transmission conditions, Freeway will operate at a range of up to 100 metres from the base unit. NB The Freeway has been designed to operate on radio frequencies which have been assigned to the exclusive use of cordless telephones.
