
## FACILITIES OF EXTENSION PLANS 5 AND 5A All systems internal only

Extension Plans 5 and 5A consist of a main telephone with a switching key and two internal extensions having limited intercommunication. This plan is designed to avoid fitting small swithboards where intercommunication is only occasionally required between telephones, especially where an Extension Plan 7 or 7A already exists and a second internal extension is required. The second extension is connected in parallel with the first extension.

## FACILITIES:-

incoming calls are received normally at the main telephone. One extension may be arranged to receive incoming calls when desired. Exchange calls from the main telephone cannot be heard at the extensions. Extension—to—exchange calls are not secret from the main or other extension on Plan 5, but they are secret from the main, although not the other extension, on Plan 5A. The main can hold an exchange call and speak to an extension without being heard on the exchange line. An indicator at the main shows when the exchange line is in use by an extension, except in CBS 2 and 3 exchange areas. In LB areas the switching key and indicator is wall—mounted. In CB and Auto areas it may be wall—mounted if required. Press—button signalling is normally provided from the main to the extensions and vice versa. For new work a Plan 105 and 105A is provided instead of Plan 5 and 5A.
