direct-wired and all key-calling providing full inter-communication between all the instruments. No automatic switchboard is necessary — all calls are made and answered by a flick of the appropriate key.

Two systems are available:

● **11 point**

- 1 Loudspeaking Master + 10 Sub-stations or
- 2 Loudspeaking Masters + 9 Sub-stations

● **15 point**

- 1 Loudspeaking Master + 14 Sub-stations or
- 2 Loudspeaking Masters + 13 Sub-stations

Dictograph 69 Loudspeaking Master Stations

The Master stations are attractively styled in low-line Afrormosia-finished cabinets with strong visual appeal and natural loud speech reproduction. The silvered key-plate is set in a sloping front to make the nameplates easy to read.

Amplifier

Specially designed transistor amplifier contained within instrument cabinet.

Incoming Calls

Announced audibly by buzzer; identification of calling extension provided by lamp signal adjacent to appropriate key.

Buzzer Cut-off

When the user wishes, the buzzer cut-off switch can be used to obviate interruption.

Volume Control

The transistor-amplified loudspeaker output can be personally controlled.

Loudspeaking Extensions

These can be fitted to provide loudspeaking/reply facilities for not more than two other departments. The latter are provided with a special loudspeaker which enables speedy response to be given to calls from the master instrument.

Tie Lines

The DICTOGRAPH 69 system can be linked to other internal telephone systems in separate premises by the use of rented external wires.

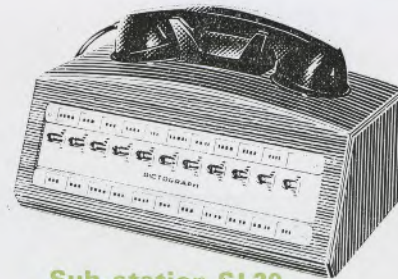

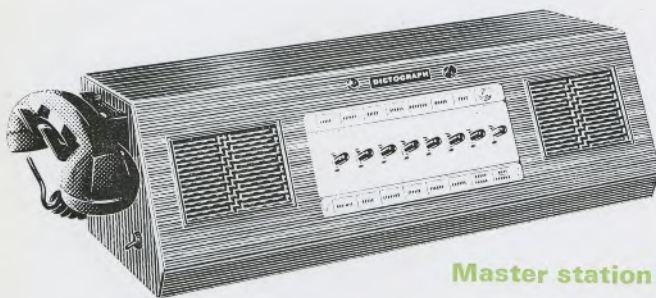

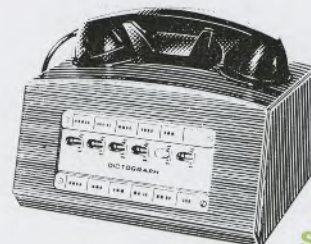

Nameplates

Engraved to individual requirements.

Incoming calls

Normally signalled by a buzzer mounted inside the instrument. A call from a master station is denoted by a distinctive signal.

Lamp indication

A call from a Master station is instantly identified by the illumination of a lamp associated with each Master station line.

Outgoing Calls— to Sub-stations

By selecting the required extension key followed by momentary operation of the RING key.

to Master stations

As above but do not depress the RING key.

Selective Inter-communication

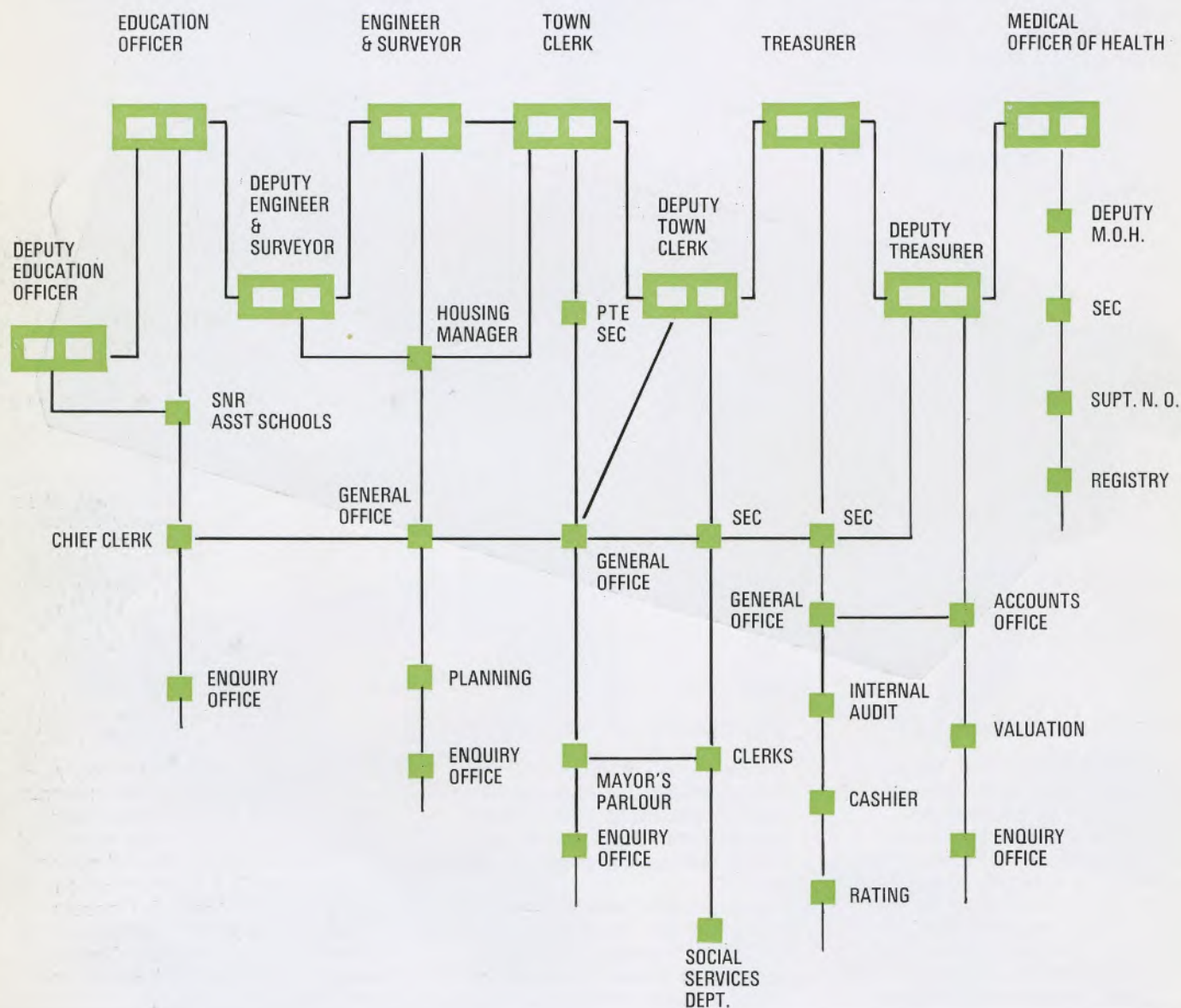
In many large organisations it is not always necessary or desirable that every person should have direct communication with every other person. Chief executives talk to very few personnel outside their own departments — apart from other Departmental Chiefs — whilst many of the members of the staff rarely have occasion to converse with people in other departments.

A typical situation arises in local government, where staff nearly always work in more-or-less well defined groups — Town Clerk's department, Borough Engineer's department, Borough Treasurer's department, Medical Officer's department, and so on.

In this plan each department has a self-contained installation but with Chiefs given access also to other Departmental Chiefs.

The layout illustrated below suggests the general chain of control which is obtained by the use of a DICTOGRAPH Multi-Master system with selective communication in a local government situation.

For organisations where full inter-communication is a necessity there is the DICTOMATIC Multi-Master system, see Leaflet T482 for full details.
