and Telephone No. 196 minus Cord.

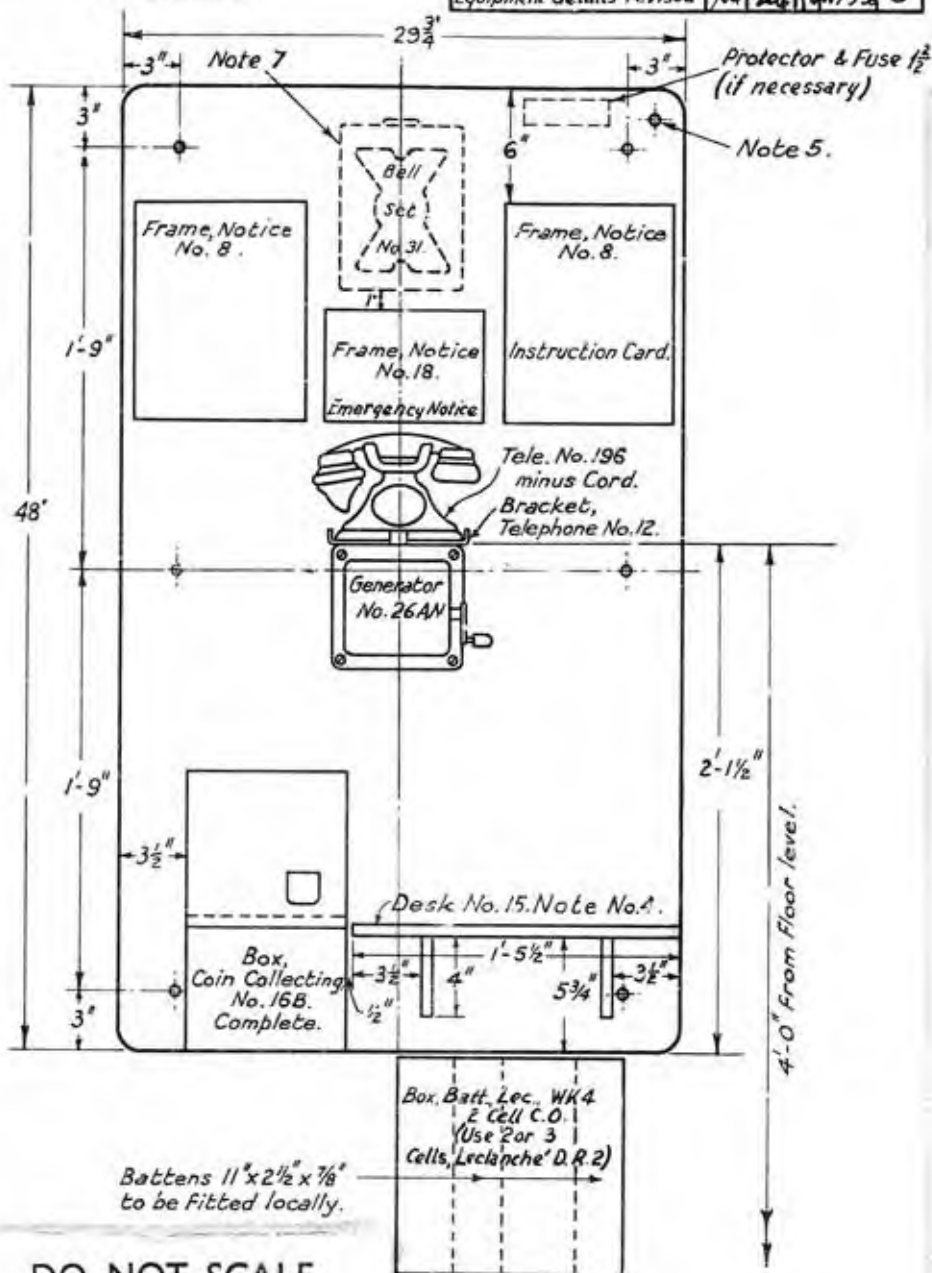

- No wiring to appear on face of Wallboard
- In non-standard cabinets the layout should conform as nearly as possible to that of the standard cabinet and Wallboard 48"x29 3/4" will be used whenever the width of the cabinet permits. The Wallboard will be mounted centrally between the sides of the cabinet in all cases.
- The bottom edge of Bracket, Telephone No. 12 should be 4'-0" from Floor level.
- The Directory should lie Flat on Desk No. 15; the cord should be passed through hole in desk and fastened to desk bracket.
- In non-standard cabinets where the width does not permit the fitting of Desk No. 15 a Desk No. 17 should be provided, the directory being suspended from a screw-eye fitted at the top right-hand corner of Wallboard.
- The Instruction and Emergency Notice Cards, will be supplied by the T.M. or H.P.M.
- Bellset No. 31 will only be required when the obsolescent "Box C.C.No.16 Complete" is used.
