
PLAN 8A



Plan 8A consists of two exchange lines and one internal extension with secrecy.

Incoming calls are received normally at the main telephones.

The main telephones can call the extension by press button, operating a trembler bell or buzzer to distinguish between the two lines.

A two position switch enables the user at the extension to connect his telephone to either exchange line, at the same time disconnecting the associated main telephone.

The indicators on the unit at the extension show when the exchange lines are in use by the main telephones.

The main telephones are secret against the extension and each other and the extension is secret against both mains.

Intercommunication between telephones is not provided.

Plan 8A has all 300-type telephones.

This Plan arrangement is now obsolescent and is superseded for new work by the Plan 108A.
