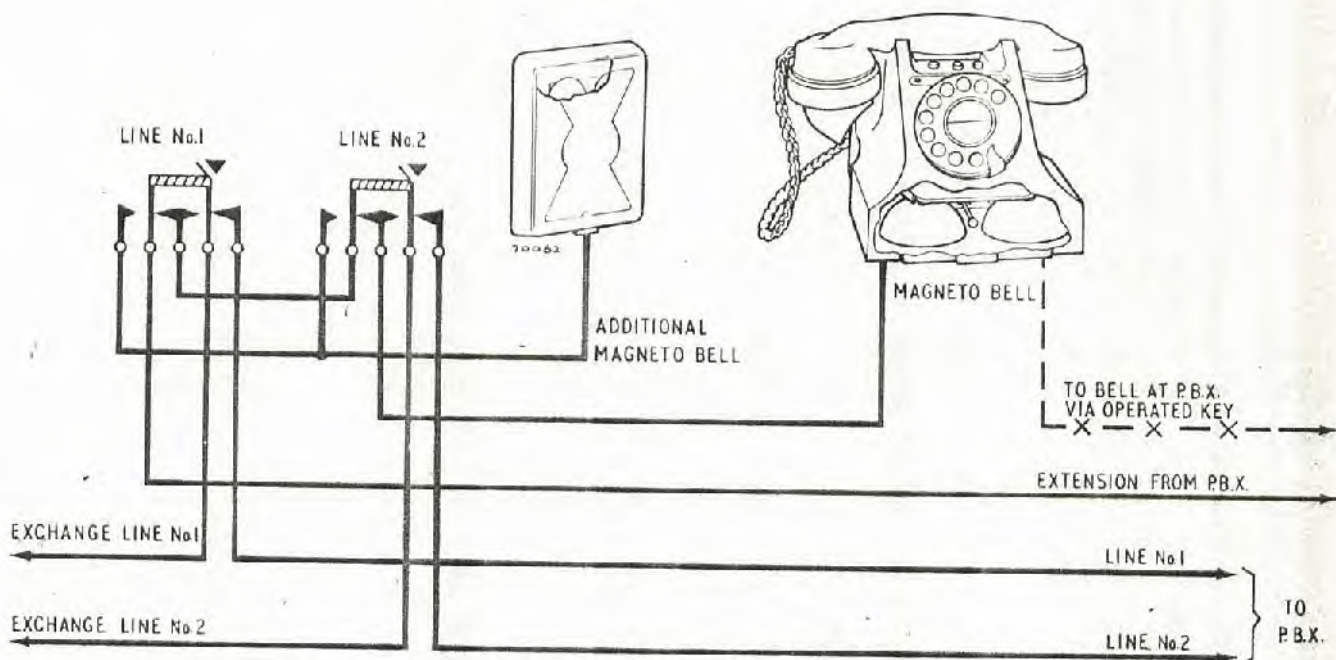


PLAN 10
*(Obsolescent)

Plan 10 consists of an internal PMBX extension which has secrecy from the PBX operator on exchange line calls.

All calls to and from the extension must be connected initially via the PBX, otherwise operating and service difficulties will arise.

* When the extension user requires secrecy from the PBX, the key associated with the exchange line in use is operated after an exchange call has been established, to connect the telephone direct to the exchange line and terminate the extension line on a local magneto bell.

* One or two exchange lines may be intercepted by use of press buttons. Replacement of the handset will restore the circuit to normal.

Where more than one line can be intercepted, the operator must advise the extension user which exchange line is being used.

When a recall button is fitted it is only effective when all secrecy buttons or keys are normal.

The provision of plan 10 on PABX extensions raises technical difficulties; requests should be dealt with as for non-standard facilities.

Plan 10 has either a 300- or 700-type telephone.

* There is no superseding item; instead customers requesting this type of facility should be offered an additional exchange line.
