
PLANS 108 AND 108A



Plans 108 and 108A consist of two main telephones, table or wall mounted, and one extension telephone, table or wall mounted.

Incoming calls are received normally at the appropriate main telephone and can be extended to the extension; the main telephone on line 1 calls the extension by press button which operates a buzzer in the extension telephone; the main telephone on line 2 calls the extension by press button which operates a trembler bell fitted near the extension.

Press buttons on the extension telephone connect that telephone to either line. Replacing the handset restores these buttons to normal.

All telephones call the exchange direct. Lamp signals at the extension telephone indicate when a line is engaged by the appropriate main telephone.

The magneto bell in the extension telephone is associated with one line. This bell can be switched on or off by a press button on the telephone.

Intercommunication between main and extension telephones is not provided.

Exchange calls on one main cannot be heard by the other main. On Plan 108, extension to exchange calls are not secret from the associated main. On Plan 108A, secrecy from the main can be provided on either or both lines.

Plans 108 and 108A have 700-type telephones.

The extension must be internal.

The main telephones are single button instruments; the extension telephone is a 4-button instrument.

They can be provided on exclusive exchange lines in CB and Auto areas only.

A power unit 101 mm x 152 mm x 101 mm (43 " x 6" x 4"), normally wall mounted, is fitted near the extension telephone. Customers must provide a B33 pin mains socket outlet, of at least 2 amps rating. Should as AC supply not be available, the local Engineering Division should be consulted.

The Plan 2A may be associated with any PBX; however on 2 + 6, 3 + 12, 4 + 18 and 5 + 25 switchboards this will be only via auxiliary apparatus connected in the 'two wire' position.

The plan is only available in 700 type telephones but not self-contained or ABX keyphones.
